Background

Bioversity International (CGIAR) is seeking to hire a Junior Professional Officer (JPO) for the Sustainable Cocoa Value Chain project in West Africa, focusing on Côte d'Ivoire and Guinea. The project funded by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation aligns with Italy's G7 Apulia commitments as part of the e G7 Apulia Food Systems Initiative (AFSI) and part of the Italian strategic planning for the Piano Mattei for Africa. The project will tackle challenges in the cocoa sector, enhance sustainability, and foster economic growth. The project led by Bioversity International leverages CGIAR's expertise in cocoa and agricultural research for development and will be implemented in collaboration with various partners including Save the Children, CIHEAM Bari, and the private sector.

Responsibilities/Job Description

The JPO will primarily focus on the technical aspects of value chain development. Key responsibilities include:

- Project Design: Contribute to the development and planning of project activities ensuring they are well-structured and aligned with overall goals.
- Project Coordination: support the execution of various project activities, ensuring timely progress and effective communication among team members and stakeholders.
- Research and Analysis: Conduct field research and analyze data to support the development of sustainable value chains, focusing on improving soil fertility, managing pests and diseases, and increasing yields.



- Stakeholder Engagement: Support the engagement with local farmers, cooperatives, government agencies, and private sector partners to ensure the project.
- Monitoring and Evaluation: Assist in creating and implementing frameworks to monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of project interventions.
- Reporting: Prepare comprehensive reports and share project findings and best practices with relevant stakeholders.

Requirements (Qualifications and Experience)

- Education: Master's degree in Agricultural Sciences, Environmental Science, Sustainable Development, or a related field.
- Experience: At least 3 years of experience in agricultural research, value chain development, or sustainable agriculture projects.

- Support the definition of a communication plan to facilitate effective coordination among team members and stakeholders
- Participate in the establishment of monitoring and evaluation frameworks for project activities.
- Prepare and distribute the first comprehensive report on project activities and findings.

Year 2

- Refine and adjust the project plan based on Year 1 findings and stakeholder feedback.
- Support and coordinate the implementation of key project activities
- Analyze data from field research to identify successful practices and areas needing improvement.
- Organize workshops with stakeholders to review progress and adjust strategies.
- Organize stakeholder workshops to share project findings and promote best practices.

The JPO will develop his/her skills in partnership building and program design, will be exposed to the work of an international research organization.
